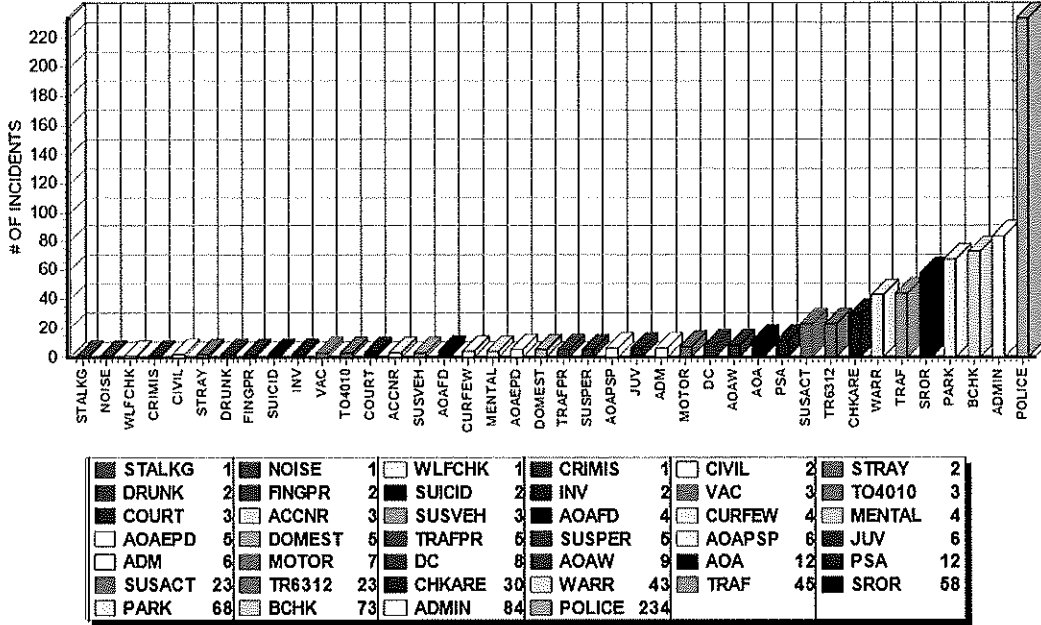

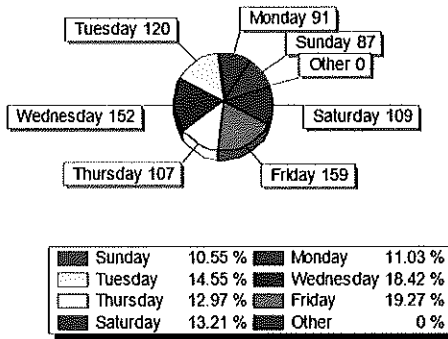

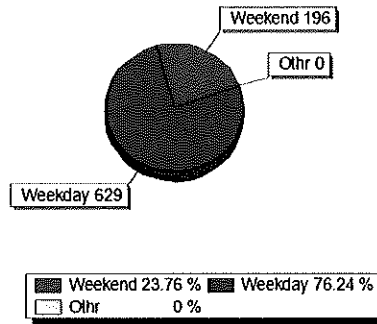
Incident Frequency by TYPE (Top 40 of 55 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
